Aztec Industries, Inc.</u>, Cause No. 90-CA-85 (December 31, 1992), \$5000.00 is a reasonable attorney's fee in this matter, particularly in light of the fact that significant post-judgment attorney's fees are likely to be incurred by plaintiff in pursuit of the defendant(s) and in the collection of the debt.
- 4. The above and foregoing represents my opinion regarding attorney's fees to be awarded in this case and I am competent to testify to the same.
