MS Levee Board Public Hearing on One Lake Proposal Thursday, 29 August 2013; MS Ag Museum

Environmental and Economic Concerns

Our treasured Pearl River is threatened as an 'endangered waterway.' With its impoundment in 1960, a beautiful lake was created, but unintended consequences subsequently occurred all along the down stream to the Gulf, including greater storm erosion, dwindling flows, damage to wildlife habitat, and diminished yields for seafood industries. Now an additional obstruction is proposed which will further damage this river and have more serious consequences for down stream.

But Central Mississippi needs greater economic opportunities, especially jobs. The One Lake proposal would provide such benefits in the short run, but at what costs?

- The lake would destroy the Pearl as a river from the Rez to below Richton, including much of the Natchez Trace State Park. This park provides a significant home to migrating birds and wildlife, including two endangered species (i.e., sawback turtle, Gulf Sturgeon), and is an outdoor classroom for education and research of all our citizens.
- Its effectiveness as a 'flood control project' is questionable given the frequent engorgement of creeks in the Jackson MSA with actual or near flooding, of homes, businesses, and infrastructures.
- The development may benefit persons directly on the lake, but will bar access to the river by the rest of our citizens.

The cost/benefit ratio is not equal with much higher costs in long range problems.

So how do we save the Pearl while fostering development?

- Number One is to preserve the remainder of the river as free flowing from the Reservoir to the Gulf.
- Develop a 'Greenway' through the Jackson MSA to preserve the river and its immediate environment while making it more accessible for ecotourism, recreation, and development along the greenway rather than a lake.
- Maintain the integrity of the river, communities, and industries down stream by
 fostering their development of the greenway through their jurisdictions as has been
 done along the Arkansas, Tennessee, and Wolf Rivers, to mention a few, with much
 economic success and little harm to the environment.

As a citizen of Jackson and Mississippi, I urge the Levee Board to consider seriously the alternatives to further damage of the Pearl River and the possibilities of turning this potential disaster into a success for all our people. Thank you for your consideration of this alternative.

To whom it may concern,

I am writing concerning the One Lake Project proposed for the Pearl River. Little is known about this project and it would seem that the proponents of it will do their best to keep it that way and squelch any voices of opposition through the format that they've adopted through their meeting process.

The footprint of this project must not include LeFluer's Bluff State Park (LBSP). LBSP is a wondrous resource for the people of Jackson. It provides people with access to a natural environment and riparian habitat that is found in no other park in Jackson. I am an educator for the Jackson Chapter of the Audubon Society, and this past summer I had the privilege of leading several children on a field trip throughout the park. It was a magnificent experience for the children. They were exposed to wildlife that they would have never have been able to see otherwise, and for the inner city children this park is perhaps the only exposure to true nature they will have growing up. To rob them of this would be criminal. How many potential careers in the natural sciences may never be realized if these children lose LBSP? Because of its size and unique riparian, hardwood and bottom land habitats the experience that is LBSP can never be duplicated. Once it has been destroyed that one of a kind experience for the inner city youth of Jackson is gone forever.

LBSP has been declared an Important Bird Area by the National Audubon Society. Important Bird Areas (IBAs) provide essential habitat for one or more breeding, wintering, and/or migrating bird species. Cornell University's Lab of Ornithology has listed LBSP as a birding hot spot. A birding hotspot is an area that is of vital importance to multiple species. To destroy this habitat would not only put the permanent avian residents at great risk (complete list provided), but it would be a serious blow to the number avian species that use as their summer breeding grounds. Species such as the prothonotary Warbler, black-crowned night heron, yellow-billed cuckoo, American redstart, and many others would have yet another prime breeding habitat ripped away from them.

This project has been cloaked with the words flood control when in reality it is merely a real estate investment. There are a good many people poised to make a lot of money from this project. If this project is truly for flood control then move its footprint further down the Pearl River where it would not impact such fragile habitat as that found in LBSP. The bottom line is that this project is motivated by greed and has given no consideration to the environmental impact it would have on the wildlife and threatened species found within its targeted bounds. The ringed Saw-back turtle and the gulf sturgeon are listed as threatened on the endangered species list and the ringed saw-back is endemic to Mississippi and is found nowhere else in the world other than the Pearl River. These turtles have made LBSP a stronghold for their species, and to destroy it would deliver a blow to them that they might never

recover from. Therefore, it is vital that any environmental impact study that is done be manned by an impartial entity.

Finally, any change to the course or flow rate of the Pearl River will have tragic consequences for all the downstream populations. You cannot rob Peter to pay Paul in the name of a real estate deal cloaked as flood control. Whatever attempt to tame the floodwaters of the Pearl River is made, it must be done with a high degree of research both for its environmental impact and the potential detrimental effects it would have for the cities and people located downstream.





Possible Features of a Comprehensive Watershed Wide Plan to Address Flood Damage Reduction, Environmental Restoration, and Recreational Needs in the Upper Pearl River Basin in Mississippi

- 1. A single lake in the Jackson Metro Area extending from just below I-20 upstream to the low head dam at the Water Works just downstream from LeFleur's Bluff State Park. Water surface elevation of the lake should not exceed the elevation of the top of the low head dam so as to not adversely affect the natural environment of lowland portions of LeFleur's Bluff State Park and the recreational facilities around Mayes Lakes.
- Dredging of portions of the new lake area to insure water depths will be sufficient to address flood conveyance needs and use of dredged material to create islands in the lake that can be used for recreational purposes.
- 3. Construction of a fish passage structure at the weir or dam creating the lake.
- 4. Purchase of a flowage easement on properties and removal of structures downstream of the Ross Barnett Reservoir dam that currently limit rapid release of stored waters in advance of expected heavy rainfall events upstream. Coupled with this should be a moratorium on any future flood prone development in the floodplain.
- 5. Enhanced use of the Ross Barnett Reservoir to store flood flows after drawdown in anticipation of flood events made possible by purchase of flowage easements and removal of flood prone properties downstream of the dam.
- 6. Purchase of appropriate easements and construction of multiple dry dam floodwater retention structures in the upper watershed of the Pearl River basin (various sizes and locations throughout the watershed). Focus should be on locations where landowners are willing to sell easements and allow construction.
- 7. Removal of existing low head dams in the Upper Pearl Basin or construction of fish passage structures at those dams.
- 8. Implementation of actions downstream from the Ross Barnett Reservoir to address problems due to bank caving and erosion-especially in locations threatening human life and property (e.g. Town of Monticello).
- 9. Provision for providing sufficient low flows in the Lower Pearl River during times of the year when this is currently a problem. This may require increased release of water from the Ross Barnett Reservoir during such periods. Coupled with this should be a detailed plan to reduce point and non-point source water pollution throughout the basin.
- 10. Construction of additional levees to protect populated areas in the Jackson Metro area that may remain vulnerable to flooding in spite of implementation of the other flood damage reduction measures proposed.
- 11. Construction of new parks and recreational trails throughout the watershed in conjunction with other project features.
- 12. Development of a detailed fish and wildlife mitigation plan that will address compensation for unavoidable direct and indirect adverse environmental impacts to fish and wildlife resources, wetlands, bottomland forests, water bodies, and other significant environmental resources.

As a resident of Jackson, I take advantage of the lovely trails between Mayes Lake and the Mississippi Museum of Natural Science regularly. I go there to bird watch, observe the changing of seasons, and to give my out-of-town guests a nice outdoors experience within the city limits. My brother-in-law brings his scout troop there to connect the kids to something other than their x-box or smartphones. It is a wonderful space. As the only real green space in Jackson, I find this area invaluable. I am concerned that there will be a loss of this important recreational area if the Single Lake plan goes through.

In addition to this being a prime recreational space...I worry for the wildlife and know that could damage irrevocably animals and the habitat that they need to survive. : Cases in point, The Ringed Sawback Turtle...which I believe is a unique species to our part of the world, to sturgeon habitat, and to the Wood Thrush, which needs woods like these.

If you are truly concerned about Flood control....then I urge you to consider levees and a greenway instead of the lake.

We all live downstream. Whatever we do here will affect anyone (person and animal) that lives downstream of this proposed change. .

All downstream interests need to be taken into consideration, especially the evaporation from the Barnett Reservoir, and the massive sediment problems that the river has had from 47 years of operation. If a Single Lake project goes through this will only serve to disturb the Pearl further.

Be wise and save Jackson from the endeavor of the Single Lake Project. Help provide flood control by considering levees and a greenway.

Be the champion that this city needs.

Mr. Turner:

I welcome the opportunity to have a meeting with you so you can hear Gulf Restoration Network's Concerns. One of the organization's goals is to ensure that coasal and estuarine habitats are protected and restored in order to support healthy wildlife and resilient, sustainable communities. A second goal is to ensure that clean flowing waterways connected to the Gulf of Mexico sustain ecologically vibrant resources that support habitat, wildlife, and communities.

These two goals form the basis of GRN's objection to further alteration of the fresh water flows of the Pearl River by constructing any more dams and lakes on it.

The Pearl River's fresh water discharge to the coast has been altered and diminished since the completion of the Ross Barnett Reservoir in 1963. A 32,000 acre reservoir serves to evaporate much more of the river's water than a smaller, unaltered river channel. The loss of water through evaporation to the atmosphere affects the coastal region more during droughts and annual periods of low rainfall than it does at other times of the year. The annual period of low river flows and low rainfall covers the months from July to October. Evaporation during any month of the year is significantly greater from the surface of a lake or reservoir than from the river that is impounded to create it.

The last time a feasibility study and Draft EIS were prepared for a Pearl River project dam/lake project was ten years ago. I attended two scoping meetings for the Two Lakes or LeFleur's Lakes project as it was called in 2003-2004. At the scoping meeting in Biloxi, staff from the Mississippi Department of Marine Resouces, Seafood Division and from the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries and the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals all attended. They came specifically to voice their comments that the feasibility study and EIS being prepared then should include predicted effects from a lake project on fresh water flows and salinities at the coast. Those questions were relevant to the health of seafood production in both states, and oyster production in particular.

The following quote is from the comments given by Scott Gordon, Shellfish Bureau Director from the Mississippi Department of Marine Resources, Seafood Division. Mr. Gordon is still head of this Bureau in 2013.

"Mississippi's major oyster reefs are concentrated along the extreme western part of the Mississippi Sound south of Pass Christian. The freshwater coming into the Sound from the Pearl River keeps the salinity at levels favorable for oysters. Some reefs are scattered across the rest of the coastline that do not have the same flow of freshwater as does the western side of the state. Water quality is influenced by the accumulative effect of all actions that occur within the entire watershed boundary. The primary threats to the oyster population in Mississippi are fluctuations and environmental parameters, particularly salinity. As long as the freshwater inflows to Mississippi Sound remain unchanged, oyster populations will continue to follow historical trends."

Scott Gordon Comments, March 11, 2004, Scoping Meeting Draft Supplemental EIS for Pearl River Watershed, hosted at DMR building Biloxi, Ms by Gary Walker, Vicksburg District.

After the scoping meeting, these comments about freshwater flow to the coast seem to have been ignored by the feasibility study and draft EIS covering the Two Lakes or Lefleur Lakes project. It is hard to tell because neither one was released to the public by the Corps of Engineers, Vicksburg District.

In the present scoping process, Gulf Restoration Network asks specifically for fresh water flows to the coast and resulting salinites to be studied, modeled and reported on so that we can know about the present Pearl River freshwater discharge to the coast, what has been lost historically due to the building of the Ross Barnett Reservoir, and what the expected evaportion effect will be from another lake of about 1500-2000 acres. In other words, we want to know what volume of fresh water annually reaches the coast now, how that is different from what reached the coast annually during pre-Ross Barnett times, how the Reservoir has changed flows to the coast and what the cumulative effect will be from an additional lake in Jackson, downstream of the Ross Barnett Reservoir.

Gulf Restoration Network's other concerns are about how much of LeFleur's Bluff State Park will be condemned or dredged to create a lake on the Pearl River. We would like to see a map of the footprint of a lake dreged on the Pearl River for this project. We also are concerned with wetland loss and habitat loss for two endangered species, Gulf sturgeon, and Ringed sawback turtle and what the mitigation plans will be for these species.

We reserve the right to comment on any subjects appropriate for scoping, including all issues listed in the Federal Register notice of the scoping meeting for this project.
