On Aug. 4, 1971 I was assigned to the courtroom by Lt. Watson while the trial of Richard Henry AKA "Imari Obadele", was being held on the charge of assault.

Court ended at approximately 5:45 PM with the Judge finding Obadele Guilty and fined him \$100.00. Obadele along with two other N/M's and his lawyer got up and walked to the Sgts. Office and I followed them and stood outside the door in the hall, along with several other Officers. Obadele came out in the hall and said "Wheres Skinner" he did not address his question to me and I said nothing but more or less made a statement. in a matter of a few minutes, Lt. Skinner was walking down the hall and stopped a few feet from me and was standing there. Obadele came outside and walked directly up to Lt. Skinner and said "I heard that you said that I was meek as a lamb when I was arrested the other day". Lt. Skinner replied "Thats right". Obadele then said "Well we'll see next time", Lt. Skinner then said "I'll probably be back out there again." Obadele then said "Well we will be ready for you and you will find out", "Wheter you know it or not, I am a Commander and I Know it is going to be a long Revolution". With this statement Obadele turned and walked back in the Sgt Office where his lawyer and the other two N/M's were and when the lawyer posted the Fine, they walked to the elevator and left.
