COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2306

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SANCTUARY CITIES; TO 2 AUTHORIZE ALL MISSISSIPPI LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO ASSIST 3 FEDERAL AGENCIES BY LEGALLY DETAINING ILLEGAL ALIENS; TO INDEMNIFY 4 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS ACT; AND FOR 5 RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) No official or governing authority of a 8 municipality of this state may limit or restrict the enforcement 9 of federal immigration laws to less than the full extent permitted 10 by federal law.

(2) A state, county or municipal law enforcement agency 11 12 shall notify federal immigration authorities of the incarceration of a person who is not legally present in the United States and 13 shall fully honor any detainer placed by federal immigration 14 15 authorities upon a person who is not legally present in the United 16 States.

17 (3) This section shall be implemented in a manner consistent with federal laws regulating immigration, protecting the civil 18

19 rights of all persons and respecting the privileges and immunities 20 of United States citizens.

21 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) All law enforcement officers of this state 22 shall assist federal agencies in the enforcement of federal 23 immigration law.

(2) If an alien who is unlawfully present in the United
States is convicted of a violation of state or local law, on
discharge from imprisonment or on the assessment of any monetary
obligation that is imposed, the United States Immigration and
Customs Enforcement or the United States Customs and Border
Protection shall be notified immediately.

30 (3) Notwithstanding any other law, a law enforcement agency 31 may securely transport to a federal facility in this state or to 32 any other point of transfer into federal custody that is outside 33 the jurisdiction of the law enforcement agency an alien for whom 34 the agency has received verification that the alien is unlawfully 35 present in the United States and is in the agency's custody.

36 (4) A law enforcement officer shall not be liable in any 37 civil action for an arrest based on probable cause and in good 38 faith under this section, or failure, in good faith, to make an 39 arrest under the authority this section. A law enforcement 40 officer is indemnified by the law enforcement officer's agency against reasonable costs and expenses, including attorney's fees, 41 42 incurred by the officer in connection with any action, suit or proceeding brought pursuant to this section in which the officer 43

44 may be a defendant by reason of the officer being or having been a 45 member of the law enforcement agency.

46 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 47 and after July 1, 2016.
