ORDER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE MISSISSIPPI BUREAU OF INVESTIGATIONS AND THE CITY OF JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI FOR THE INVESTIGATION OF OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING INCIDENTS AND IN-CUSTODY DEATHS.

WHEREAS, the Mississippi Bureau of Investigations (MBI) is an investigative agency under the Mississippi Department of Public Safety tasked with investigating, reporting and preventing criminal activities; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson, Mississippi Police Department desires to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Mississippi Bureau of Investigations and the City of Jackson, Mississippi Police Department to investigate incidents of officer involved shootings and in-custody deaths; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this MOU is to allow MBI to provide an independent investigation into incidents involving City of Jackson police officer shootings and in custody deaths; and

WHEREAS, this MOU shall remain in full force and effect until either party terminates this MOU by written notice.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Mayor of the City of Jackson is authorized to enter into the herein-described Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Jackson, Mississippi and the Mississippi Bureau of Investigations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Mayor or his designee be authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to facilitate the terms of the herein-described Memorandum of Understanding.
